Brisbane swimmers represented Queensland on the following teams:

#### **2019 State Teams Championships**

- 13 boys | 15 girls (44 swimmers in total)
- 6 Coaches (out of a total of 9 coaches)

2019 marked the 11th year for the State Teams Championships and, to date, Queensland is the only state to ever win this event. In 2018, Swimming Australia piloted the inclusion of Para swimmers in this meet. In 2019, Para swimmers were included in the points score, and Queensland selected 4 Para swimmers, 3 of whom were from Brisbane Clubs.

#### **2019 Patron's Shield - Sunshine Coast**

- 25 boys | 25 girls (50 swimmers in total)
- 6 Coaches
- 2 Managers
- 3 Technical Officials

Brisbane was victorious for the 7th year in a row, dating back to 2013.

#### **2019 Inter-Region Challenge - Gold Coast at Bond**

- 21 boys | 25 girls
- 6 Coaches
- 2 Managers
- 1 Technical Official

The 2019 Inter-Region Challenge was the inaugural meet for Brisbane Swimming and Swimming Gold Coast. The Inter-Region Challenge is an extension of the Patron's Shield meet concept, targeting older age group swimmers. It was designed to give a quality racing experience in a team-based representative competition to selected swimmers.

At the **Queensland State Championships**, Brisbane continued to field two teams in the Regional Relays. Brisbane Teams won 8 Gold, 4 Silver, and 6 Bronze medals. Our thanks go to Relay Team Managers, Ray Clarson and Louisa Forrester, for once again ensuring that all our swimmers were present and correct for their races.

The **Region's total membership** currently stands at 84 clubs, with 7,750 members. It is pleasing to see that our competitive swimmers' membership rose slightly from last year's figures. Our thanks go to Julie Majer and her team for working so hard on the new Swim Central system.

Brisbane region invested heavily in **development activities**, this season expending over \$59,000 in this key area:

### **Brisbane Stroke Training Sessions**

- Three x 2-hour form stroke-specific training sessions (24 Aug | 7 Sept | 21 Sept 2019)
- The training sessions are specifically designed and tailored around each form stroke and are of great benefit to the swimmers attending.
- 43 swimmers in total (swimmers were able to attend 1, 2 or 3 sessions)

### **July 2019 Big Brisbane Camp**

- 31 swimmers
- 7 Coaches
- 1 Manager

The Big Brisbane Camp is designed to give swimmers the chance to train, learn, and develop around swimmers in their own age group, in an enjoyable environment, with fun activities also planned.

### **2019/20 Brisbane Open Water Development Squad**

- This season, we had two activities for the Brisbane Open Water Development Squad: a pool training session in preparation for the Queensland Open Water Championships, and an open water training session in preparation for the Australian Open Water Swimming Championships.
- The first training session consisted of two components: a pool component that featured an appearance by Rio Olympian and current Australian Dolphin Team Member, Chelsea Gubecka, and a nutrition component that was presented by Steph Cronin, who is employed by Apple to Zucchini as a Performance Nutritionist. The nutrition component of the session was only for swimmers aged 13 to 18 years who participated in the 2.5km, 5km or 7.5km events.
  - 42 participated in the first training session (7 Oct 2019)
    - 17 participated in the first component only
    - 25 swimmers participated in both components
- The second training session took place with Grimsey Adult Swimfit at Suttons Beach, Redcliffe. This training session was only for swimmers aged 13 to 18 years who participated in the 2.5km, 5km or 7.5km events.
  - 21 participated in the second training session (12 Jan 2020)

### **March 2019/20 Macca's Clinics**

Unfortunately, we did not get a chance to hold any Macca's clinics this season. Clinics were planned at Brisbane Jets on Sunday, 5 April and Woogaroo on Sunday, 17 May, however, these were required to be cancelled due to COVID-19. We will liaise with these clubs once we're good to get back in the water again!

### **Aquatic Body Alignment Clinics**

- 28 athletes & 25 parents attended the Aug 2019 ABA
- We also had a clinic planned in March but unfortunately, that did not eventuate, again because of COVID-19.

Our Regional Championships (Short Course, Open Water, Sprints, Junior and Senior Metropolitan) this season attracted 16,500 nominations. The Preparation Meets had over 35,500 nominations, with Development and Transition-level meets registering 18,800 nominations. Brisbane Swimming thanks those clubs that hosted a Preparation, Transition or Development meet and acknowledges the support of the Technical Officials who assisted with these meets.

The 2019/20 **Annual Awards Function** was cancelled this year, once again due to COVID-19; however, the awards will be presented to the swimmers at the Brisbane Short Course Championships. The awards recognise achievements of the season. The top performers were:

- **Rising Star Award:** Meg Harris (St Peters Western)
- **Glen Bigg Trophy:** Bronte Job (Rackley Swim Team)
- **Official of the Year:** Lori Chaplin (for her tireless work on pool deck)

Congratulations to all these recipients on this well-deserved recognition.

Brisbane Swimming acknowledges the continuing support of our sponsors, McDonald's and Vorgee. Both of these sponsors have had long associations with Brisbane Swimming.

Many thanks to all the Technical Officials, volunteers, club administrators, Coaches, parents and, of course, the swimmers who, in combination, are responsible for the success of Brisbane Swimming. I also acknowledge all our Life Members, many of whom continue to actively support the Association. In addition, we thank Swimming Queensland for its role in our administration, with special acknowledgement of Kellie Richter.

Sincere thanks to my fellow members of the Management Committee, Ray Clarson (Vice President), Susan Weldon (Secretary), Peter Crane (Treasurer), Melanie Edgar, Tim Dilger and David Proud, for the time they put into the running of this Association. This is my second President's Report. I have enjoyed working with all the members of the Management Committee and office staff over this past year and look forward to the next season.

# Treasurer's Report

It is with pleasure that I, on behalf of the Brisbane Swimming Association Management Committee, present for your consideration the Audited Financial Report for the year ending 31 March 2020.

An operating surplus of \$30,666 was recorded.

There is two big factors in the surplus for the season:

- West Brisbane Aquatic Club folded and donated their remaining funds to the association, that being \$18,393.88.
- The cancelation of the Sydney Open Championships Trip; unfortunately this activity did not happen due to the COVID-19 restrictions and that money was not spent.

Cash at bank is transferred between cheque, saving and term deposits accounts as required. There was an additional Term Deposit Account set up to maturity every three months to gain higher interest rate. That is on top of a term deposit is rolled over each year, on maturity in November. This is to maximise the return on cash funds.

Total Assets for the Association have increased to \$345,607, which is largely cash at bank. There remains an amount of \$322,654 in current assets. Brisbane Swimming purchased a second set of Backstroke Ledges in conjunction with Swimming Queensland, Brisbane's component was \$8,658.10.

Total Liabilities of \$51,373 are comprised of trade creditors and GST payable. The majority of these liabilities were settled in April 2020.

The Association thanks its sponsors, McDonald's and Vorgee, for their ongoing, highly-valued financial support.

I would also like to thank Swimming Queensland staff members, particularly Amanda-Jayne Noble and Catherine Johnson, all of whom undertake their roles in a professional way and go beyond what is reasonably asked of them to ensure the smooth running of the Association.

In conclusion, Brisbane Swimming had a good year and with COVID-19, there are many uncertainties regarding many sports. However, Brisbane Swimming is in a strong financial position and does not need to restrain its activities due to financial concerns. We look forward to challenges of the new season and endeavour swimming in Brisbane remains as strong or if not stronger into the future.

**1 Statement of Significant Accounting Policies**

This financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act (Qld) 1981. The committee has determined that the association is not a reporting entity.

The financial report has been prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historic costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following significant accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless stated otherwise, have been adopted in the preparation of this financial report.

**Inventories**

Inventories are measured at the lower of cost and net realisable value. The cost of manufactured products includes direct materials, direct labour and an appropriate portion of variable and fixed overheads. Overheads are applied on the basis of normal operating capacity. Costs are assigned on a first-in first-out basis.

**Property, Plant and Equipment (PPE)**

Leasehold improvements and office equipment are carried at cost less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation.

The depreciable amount of all PPE is depreciated over the useful lives of the assets to the association commencing from the time the asset is held ready for use.

Leasehold improvements are amortised over the shorter of either the unexpired period of the lease or the estimated useful lives of the improvements.

**Depreciation**

The depreciation method and useful life used for items of property, plant and equipment (excluding freehold land) reflects the pattern in which their future economic benefits are expected to be consumed by the association. Depreciation commences from the time the asset is held ready for use. Leasehold improvements are depreciated over the shorter of either the unexpired period of the lease or the estimated useful lives of the improvements. The depreciation method and useful life of assets is reviewed annually to ensure they are still appropriate.

**Report on the Audit of the Financial Report**

**Opinion**

We have audited the financial report of Brisbane Swimming Association Inc, which comprises the assets and liabilities statement as at 31 March 2020, the income and expenditure statement for the year the ended, notes comprising a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information, and the certification by members of the committee on the annual statements giving a true and fair view of the financial position and performance of the association.

In our opinion, the accompanying financial report presents fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the association as at 31 March 2020 and its financial performance for the year then ended in accordance with the accounting policies described in Note 1 to the financial statements and the requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act (Qld) 1981.

**Basis for Opinion**

We conducted our Audit in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Report section of our report. As a result, the financial report may not be suitable for another purpose. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

**Responsibilities of the Committee for the Financial Report**

The committee is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial report in accordance with the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act (Qld) 1981 and for such internal control as the committee determines is necessary to enable the preparation and fair presentation of a financial report that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial report, the committee is responsible for assessing the association's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters relating to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the committee either intends to liquidate the association or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.
