Age	Age at 19 November, 2022 (Minimum age is 8 years for Junior events, while the minimum age for Open Events is 11 years)
Eligibility	Entry is open to Swimming Queensland “Competitive” registered swimmers, who are members of an affiliated club with Swimming Queensland.  Clubs Allocated – AJ’s, Ambrose Treacy, ASA Swim Team, Ashgrove Tridents, Bethania, Boonah Centenary Dolphins, CYMS St Edmunds, Greenbank Gators, Ipswich Grammar, Ipswich Vikings, Ipswich Community Ironsides, Ithaca Creek, Jamboree Heights, Karalee, Lakes, Lowood, Railways, Rosewood, St Peters Western, The Gap The Swim Academy (Brisbane), Waterworx, Western Aquatics, Woogaroo

Events	As per attached program of events. All events will be swum as timed finals. The referee's decision is final, and the Meet Referee has the right to combine heats on the day. If this occurs, this will impact the timeline.
Multiclass	Multiclass Swimmers are eligible to swim in all events
Medals	Medals will be awarded to the fastest three placegetters in each age group for the 50m and 100m events (8, 9, 10, 11, 12,13, 14, 15 years & over). Fastest three placegetters overall will be awarded medals in the Open events (200m, 400m, 800m and 1500m).
Nomination	\$9.75 per event (via Swim Central, plus online credit card transaction fee of 1.5%)
COVID-19 Safe Event	In order to comply with Queensland Government regulations for the running of COVID-Safe Events, all nominees must confirm they agree to the below - <a href="#">SQ COVID-19 Terms of Entry and Attendance at Events</a>
Marshalling	All swimmers will be required to self-marshall in the allocated marshalling area as per the following – 50m, 100m & 200m events – Three heats prior to the heat in the water
Pool Entry	Swimmers - \$0 Coaches - \$0 Entry fee for Spectators is \$5.00 per person
Rules	NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED. ALL PAYMENTS WILL BE CONTACTLESS. This meet will be conducted under SQ / SAL Rules. No rule tolerance will apply.

Closing Date	Swim Central entries will close on <b>Tuesday, 8 November at 11.59pm</b>
Late entries	A final entry list will be published on the event page on or before Wednesday 17 November, detailing event number, heat and lane for swimmers to use for self-marshalling.
General	No late entries will be permitted.
Other	There will be a BBQ running during the meet and there is also a canteen where you can purchase a range of food plus coffee, tea etc. NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED.  All Clubs will receive email confirmation of their entries. Meet entry list, estimated timeline and timekeeping roster will also be emailed. Programs will be emailed to all attendees. Programs will not be available for purchase on the day of the carnival.  All Clubs competing are asked to provide timekeepers during the meet based on number of nominated swimmers. Details of lane allocation(s) will be provided to clubs and also contained in the meet program.  ALL clubs nominating swimmers in distance events are required to provide timekeepers and lap counters for these events.  Raffles tickets will be on sale. Lots of prizes to be won!
