Awards:	Medals will be awarded to the 3 fastest swimmers in the following age groups: <ul style="list-style-type: none">50m events: Multi Class, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 Years & Over100m Freestyle: Multi Class, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 Years & OverOther 100m events: Multi Class, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 Years & OverAll Open events: Multi Class, 1st, 2nd, 3rd place overall <p><i>Please note all swimmers are responsible for the collection of medals by the end of the meet.</i></p>

Programs:	The meet program & timeline will be emailed prior to the Meet. No programs will be available for purchase on the day. Coaches & Officials will be provided with one FREE program on the day.
Events:	As per the attached Schedule of Events; competitors will be seeded by time rather than age-group. Multi Class Swimmers can enter in any event. This is a Preparation Meet and will be conducted and run under SQ/SAL rules. All events will be swum as Timed Finals.
Timing:	Semi-automatic timing will be used and Clubs will be required to provide timekeepers on the day based on the number of nominated swimmers. All clubs with swimmers in distance events are required to provide timekeepers for these events. Albany Creek will provide a timekeeping roster prior to the event.
Self Marshalling:	Self-marshalling will take place in the allocated self-marshalling area. Swimmers will need to mark their own name off in the program for their designated lane. Then, following the directions of marshalling helpers / check starters, progress forward to their heat & lane for their race. Check starters will be present to assist swimmers if required.
Facility:	Drinks and food will be available from Albany Creek Leisure Centre Café. Albany Creek Leisure Centre has partly shaded concreted stepped area for seating. BYO chair is recommended. Clubs are welcome to bring tents to set up on the grassed area.
Refunds:	Refunds will only be given for withdrawal from the meet due to medical reasons. Please email your refund request with a medical certificate within 7 days of the meet (bank fees will be deducted).
COVID-Safe Meet Information:	We have a shared responsibility to ensure the safe running of events. We appreciate your support in making this happen by maintaining physical distancing, good hand hygiene, staying at home, and getting tested if you have symptoms.
