Age	As of 16 th April 2023,
Eligibility	Entry is open to all Swimming Queensland 'Competitive' registered swimmers. Swimmers are NOT ELIGIBLE to compete in events if their entry time is better than JX Silver standard for that event.
Events	As per attached program of events. All events will be swum as timed finals. The referee's decision is final, and the Meet Referee has the right to combine heats on the day.
Medals	Medals will be awarded to the fastest three placegetters: <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ in each age group for the 25m (8yrs), 50m events, and 100m IM (8, 9, 10, 11, 12 years).➤ 7 & under will receive a Ribbons.
Nomination	\$8.00 per event (via SwimCentral, plus online credit card transaction fee of 3%). Maximum 5 events per swimmer.

Marshalling	All swimmers will be required to self-marshall as per the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ 25m, 50m events: Three (3) heats prior to the heat in the water
General	There will be a BBQ (bacon and egg burgers) running during the meet. Coffee/drinks can be purchased through the pool kiosk. Please bring your own chairs and shade (no pegs).
Pool admission	Swimmers: Free Coaches: Free Entry fee for Spectators is \$2.00 per family.
Rules	This meet will be conducted under SQ / SAL Rules. Rule tolerance will apply on 7 years & under events (25m)

Closing Date	Online entries close on Monday 10th April @ 11.59pm. Entries will be capped at 125 swimmers. Nominations may close early if meet cap numbers are met.

OFFICIAL INFORMATION FOR COACHES, PARENTS AND COMPETITORS

1. This Development Meet has been sanctioned by Brisbane Swimming.
2. BSA Referees will be officiating at this meet.
3. The meet shall be conducted in accordance with Swimming Queensland Rules.
4. The one-start rule will apply.
5. Heats may be combined at the discretion of the Referee in consultation with the Meet Director. This includes the combining of male and female events.
6. Marshalling - swimmers must report to the self-marshalling area when required. Once a swimmer has been marshalled, they must remain in the marshalling area or risk being scratched from their event.
7. The Referee is the sole arbitrator of all disputes and their decision will be final.
