- 1. This Development Meet has been sanctioned by Brisbane Swimming.
- 2. BSA Referees will be officiating at this meet.
- 3. The meet shall be conducted in accordance with Swimming Queensland Rules.
- 4. The one-start rule will apply.
- 5. Heats may be combined at the discretion of the Referee in consultation with the Meet Director. This includes the combining of male and female events.
- 6. Marshalling swimmers must report to the self-marshalling area when required. Once a swimmer has been marshalled, they must remain in the marshalling area or risk being scratched from their event.
- 7. The Referee is the sole arbitrator of all disputes and their decision will be final.
