



2023 Rackley Hibiscus LC Transition Meet

Saturday 25th November 2023

Hibiscus Sports Complex, 90 Klumpp Road, Upper Mt Gravatt

This meet is designed as an end of year hit-out for younger swimmers and older swimmers who are not competing at the 2023 Queensland Championships.

Time	Junior Session (7-10 years): Warm up from 11:15am, racing from 12pm Senior Session (11 years +): Warm up and racing not before 2:30pm – time TBC
Nominations	All event nominations can be made through Swim Central.
Eligibility	Entry is open to all SQ registered competitive swimmers. MC swimmers are welcome and will be seeded according to Age and Time.
Age	As at 25 th November 2023 (minimum age for competitors is 7 years).
Nominations Close	Midnight Tuesday 14th November 2023. Nominations may close early if meet numbers or timeframes are met. Entries will be capped at 150 swimmers per session.
Event Fees	Fixed cost of \$35 per swimmer plus GST. A 3% system/transaction fee will be applied in the shopping trolley within Swim Central. Each swimmer can swim a maximum of 5 events.
Late Entries	We will only accept late entries if there are empty lanes. They will be entered manually with a seed time of NT into the slowest heat.
Seed Times	Swimmer seed times from swim meets in the period following nominations closing (noting that we may close early if swimmer caps are reached) and the date of our meet will not be used.
Events	This meet is sanctioned by Swimming Queensland and times will be recognised as official qualifying times for the Brisbane and Queensland Championships. All events will be swum as timed finals. The technical manager, in consultation with the referee, reserves the right to combine heats on the day.
Refunds	No refunds will be given for withdrawal from the meet unless it is due to medical reasons. If withdrawing for medical reason, please notify us as soon as practical and email your refund request with medical certificate provided within 7 days of meet (bank fees will be deducted).
Spectators	Spectators are welcome. Entry fee of \$5 per family.
Awards	Medals will be awarded to the three fastest swimmers in the following age groups: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 50m Events: 7,8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and years & over• 100m Events: 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and years & over• 200m Events: 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and years & over
Program	Will be emailed to all swimmers ahead of the meet

Timekeeping A time keeping roster will be emailed to Club Race Secretaries closer to the meet date. All Clubs competing may be required to provide timekeepers during the meet based on the number of nominated swimmers.

Facility The Hibiscus centre has a limited amount of shade and seating areas. Please bring your own chairs and shade cover.

Food We will have a BBQ running throughout the day.
The kiosk will also be open for purchase of coffee, soft drinks and other goodies.
