

# **2023 CENTENARY DOLPHINS JUNIOR TRANSITION MEET**

**SATURDAY 2nd DECEMBER 2023**

**JINDALEE POOL, 11 Yallambee Rd, Jindalee**

*This meet is sanctioned by Swimming Queensland and times will be recognised as official qualifying times for the Brisbane and Queensland Championships.*

<b>Time</b>	Warm up from 3:00pm, Racing from 4:00pm
<b>Nominations</b>	All event nominations can be made through Swim Central. The entry process is only available to financial Swimming Australia competitive members.
<b>Eligibility</b>	Entry is open to all SQ registered competitive swimmers who meet the following criteria. (Swimmers who are competing at 2023 Queensland Long Course Championships are <b>NOT</b> eligible to enter.) Maximum of 150 swimmers. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 50m events: 7 - 12 years</li> <li>• 100m Freestyle: 8 years &amp; over</li> <li>• 200m Individual Medley: 9 years &amp; over</li> </ul>
<b>Age</b>	As at 2nd December 2023
<b>Nomination Close</b>	<b>Midnight Tuesday 21st November 2023.</b> Nominations may close early if meet numbers or timeframes are met.
<b>Event Fees</b>	Fixed cost of \$35 per swimmer plus GST. A 3% system/transaction fee will be applied in the shopping trolley within Swim Central. <b>Note - Each swimmer can swim a maximum of 5 events.</b> Spectators are welcome. Entry Fee of \$5 per family.
<b>Multiclass</b>	MC swimmers welcome and will be seeded according to Age and Time.
<b>Late Entries</b>	We will only accept late entries if there are empty lanes. They will be entered manually with a seed time of NT into the slowest heat.
<b>Entries on the day</b>	Will be accepted only if there is an empty lane and must be lodged at least 45 minutes before the event. No new heats will be created. Entries on the day will be \$20 per event.
<b>Events</b>	All events will be swum as timed finals. The technical manager, in consultation with the referee, reserves the right to combine heats on the day.
<b>Refunds</b>	No refunds will be given for withdrawal from the meet unless it is due to medical reasons. All refund requests must be made via Swim Central. If withdrawing for medical reason, please notify us as soon as practical and email your refund request with medical certificate provided within 7 days of meet (bank fees will be deducted).
<b>Programs</b>	The program will be sent to all swimmers prior to the day of competition. No programs will be available for sale on the day.
<b>Awards</b>	Medals will be awarded to the three fastest swimmers in the following age groups: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 50m Events: 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 year</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 100m Freestyle: 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 year &amp; over</li> <li>• 200m IM: 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 year &amp; over</li> </ul>
<b>Timekeeping</b>	A time keeping roster will be emailed to Club Race Secretaries closer to the meet date. All Clubs competing may be required to provide timekeepers during the meet based on the number of nominated swimmers.
<b>Food/BBQ</b>	There will be a BBQ cooking and the kiosk will be open for purchase of coffee, soft drinks and other goodies.
