Times:	<p>Senior Session, 11yrs+: 9.00am races commence (Gates open 8am warm-up from 8.15am)</p> <p>Junior Session, 8&U-10yrs: Races commence TBA (warm-up TBA).</p>
Age:	As of 18th February 2024. Minimum age for competitors is 6yrs.
Eligibility:	Entry is open to all SQ registered competitive swimmers. All events will be swum as timed finals. The referee reserves the right to combine heats on the day.
Rules:	This meet will be conducted under SQ/SAL Rules and rule tolerance will be applied to designated events and age groups.
Nominations:	<p>Online entries through Swim Central.</p> <p>Entries will close: 11:59pm Tuesday 6th February 2024.</p> <p>Nominations may close early if meet numbers or timeframes are met.</p> <p>(Each Swimmer can swim a maximum of 5 individual events and meet will be capped at 150 competitors per session.)</p>
Nomination fee:	\$35 plus GST for up to 5 events. (Plus, a 1.5% system fee and a 1.5% transaction fee will be applied in the shopping trolley within swim central)
Medals:	<p>Medals will be awarded to the three fastest swimmers in the following age groups for –</p> <p>25m: 8 yrs & under, 9, 10</p> <p>50m: 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 yrs & over</p> <p>100m Free: 9,10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 yrs & over</p> <p>100m (other than free): 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 yrs & over</p> <p>200m:11, 12, 13, 14, 15 yrs & over</p>
Refunds:	No refunds will be given for withdrawal from the meet unless due to medical reasons. If withdrawing for medical reason, please notify us as soon as practical and email your refund request with medical certificate provided within 7 days of meet (bank fees will apply). Once emailed please apply for the refund through swim central.
Spectators:	Spectators are welcome and entry is free.
Timekeeping:	A time keeping roster will be emailed to Club Race Secretaries closer to the meet date. Clubs competing may be required to provide timekeepers during the meet based on the number of nominated swimmers.
Food	There will be a BBQ available on the day. There is also a kiosk where you can purchase drinks and snacks.
