2026 GRACE SHORT COURSE TRANSITION MEET

This meet is sanctioned by Swimming Brisbane & Swimming Queensland. Times will be recognised as official qualifying times for Brisbane, Queensland and Australian Championships

Date	Saturday 13th June 2026
Venue	Grace Lutheran College, Buchanan Rd, Rothwell 25m, 8 Lanes heated pool, some shaded seating provided. A canteen & BBQ will be operating from opening time.
Entry	Gates will open at 8.00am. Free Entry for Competitors, Coaches & Spectators
Time	Session 1: Junior Session 9:00am START – 8:00-8:45am Warm-up Session 2: Senior Session 12:00pm or later Start time will be confirmed after nominations close. 45 min warm-up prior to start.
Age	Age on 13th June 2026 (Minimum age is 8 years for 50m events).
Eligibility	Entry is open to all Swimming Queensland “Competitive” registered swimmers. Club registrars are to ensure all swimmers are correctly registered.
Events	As per the Program of Events. This is a ‘Transition’ Meet under SQ’s Competition Framework for Meets. All events to be swum as multi-age timed finals with awards for each separate age/group. Multi-class swimmers welcome, please email racesec@graceswim.org.au after nominating, with your name and classification so multi-class sub-events can be created. Each swimmer can swim a maximum of 5 individual events. Junior swimmers can only swim <u>one distance per stroke</u> . That means they can swim 25m or 50m per stroke, but not both. Maximum 150 swimmers per session.
Nominations	Online entry via Swim Central only. \$10 (plus transaction fees) per event. Refunds of nomination fees will only be given in the case of a medical withdrawal. A valid medical certificate must be sighted within 7 days after the completion of the meet.
Entry Closing Date	Online entries will close Wednesday 3rd June @11.59pm , or earlier if capped numbers are reached. No late entries can be accepted.

Rules	This meet will be conducted under SQ/SAL Rules. Rule tolerances will apply to swimmers seven (7) years and younger.
Timekeeping	Semi-automatic timing system will be used; two timekeepers per lane. Clubs will be allocated lanes to assist with time keeping.
Awards	Medals to be awarded to the fastest three placegetters in each age group: (7 years & under, 8, 9 years) for all 25m events, and (8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 & over) for all 50m, 100m & 200m events.
Programs	No programs available on the day. Finalised program will be emailed prior to the meet. Meet Mobile will be operating.
General Info	Food and drink will be available for purchase as well as a coffee van will be in attendance. Raffle tickets will be available to purchase in both Junior and Senior Sessions.
